

Dirty Bingo

Members need to earn as many numbers as possible.

Earn One Number For:

- * staying for the meeting
- * losing weight (for KOPS staying at or below goal)
- * turning in a food chart.

This runs for one month with the game played during the first meeting of the following month.

To Play the Game: Take a piece of card stock paper and cut it up in small squares, then number each square. Depending on how many members are in your chapter, you would count up the total amount that a person can earn and multiply it by the number of members. You will need two sets of these numbers.

On the day that we play the game, members are told how many numbers to take and then they sit down in a circle.

5 gifts are placed in the center of the circle. The leader or the member in charge of the game will draw a number from the bag and call it out.

Who ever has that number will turn in the number and go and pick up a gift.

The next number is called out, and that person can get a gift from the center or take the gift that the previous person took. This goes on and on until the members are out of numbers. Then the people who have the gifts can open them.

This game really gets funny, as members get "attached" to "their" gifts and try to win them back!
