

VALENTINES CONTEST

"DON'T BREAK MY HEART"

I did this contest last year for the month of February. I took hearts made from white construction paper and cut them into 4 pieces (made each heart a puzzle) and mounted them on red poster board. I attached the puzzle pieces to the poster by using circles of tape.

Under each heart was the name of a member. I drew around the heart on the poster board with gold glitter paint, but you could just use a marking pen if you wanted. The heart puzzles stayed put together if the member came in with a loss, stayed the same, or were in leeway. If you had a gain were out of leeway or missed a meeting one piece of the puzzle was removed from the heart and it was a broken heart.

Either way you wrote your name on the heart w/ the date or you wrote your name on the poster board after the piece was removed and put the date on it.

At the end of the contest each piece of the hearts that were left on the board were placed in a container for a drawing. Of course the more times your name was in the container the more chance you had to win.

You could have several prizes and draw for them at the end of the contest. I am a visual person and having the poster boards hanging on the walls at the meetings was a nice visual aid and also nice decorations for the month of February.
